



EDGING

To complete your garden style and to ensure easy management, Bradstone has designed edging stones which will complement your garden ideas.

You may prefer a formal approach to edging paths and flower beds to keep the soil in its proper place. In this case, try Rope-Top edgings. There are also designs for a more rustic look to suit the country garden, such as weathered Old Town and Citadel or Mellow Terracotta Tile on Edge. Whatever your preference, you'll find something suitable in Bradstone's edging collection.

A composite edging containing five overlapping 'stones' with different profiles and shapes giving the impression of stones laid on edge.

Available in three weathered shades to blend or contrast with any garden.

Stone

An authentic replica of stones laid on edge, each block is a composite of ten 'stones' for ease of laying. Corner blocks provide a neat finish to ends. With two natural looking shades, Stone edging blends well in a traditional cottage garden and it can also be used as a wall coping.
